COURSE: NJ DIVISION OF FIRE SAFETY FIREFIGHTER LEVEL 1 & 2

The Firefighter Level 1 & 2 Class starts Sunday January 5th, 2025 @ 08:00am
The class will be a combined FF1 and FF2. All students attending the class must report to the fire training center with their Chief on Sunday January 5th, 2025 @ 08:00am for orientation, CPAT Testing, FIT Testing and paperwork.

COURSE: NJ DIVISION OF FIRE SAFETY FIRE POLICE CERTIFICATION

LEAD INSTRUCTOR: CHIEF FOLEY

DATES: MONDAY JANUARY 20th, WEDNESDAY JANUARY 22nd, MONDAY JANUARY 27th, WEDNESDAY JANUARY 29th, @ 6:30pm & SUNDAY FEBRUARY 2nd @ 8:30am

This course will provide the basic knowledge & skill for all newly assigned & current Fire Police Officers, as well as those experienced firefighters involved with traffic and crowd control at an incident scene. This program meets the current New Jersey Statute 15:8-4, updated Division of Fire Safety Subchapter 7 Fire Police Officer Training concerning the training of Fire Police Officers. Topics covered are: history, demeanor, personal protective gear, Red & Blue light laws, scene size-up, workplace safety. Incident Management System (I-100, I-200, I-700 & I-800), TIMS, & Hazmat Awareness which will be included and issued a separate certificate upon completion.

The class includes indoor classroom instruction blocks and an outdoor practical evaluation. In accordance with NJ Highway Incident Traffic Guidelines for the First Responder.

Prerequisites: Class II safety vest and road flares for the outdoor practical class

COURSE: FIRE INSTRUCTOR LEVEL 2 (40 HOURS)

LEAD INSTRUCTOR: DEPUTY DIRECTOR SEAMAN

DATES: WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 5th @ 6:30PM, MONDAY FEBRUARY 10th @ 6:30PM, WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 12th @ 6:30PM, MONDAY FEBRUARY 17th @ 6:30PM, WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 19th @ 6:30PM, MONDAY FEBRUARY 24th @ 6:30PM, & WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 26th @ 6:30PM, MONDAY MARCH 3rd @ 6:30PM & WEDNESDAY MARCH 5th @ 6:30PM

Students will receive instruction to prepare them for the role of Fire Department instructor. Students will be required to give training presentations during the course. Students will be given instruction on preparing, developing and writing lesson plans. Student will receive Fire Instructor 2 certification from the State of NJ after passing the State test.

Prerequisites: Fire Instructor Level 1, Must verify a minimum of 3 years of experience of instructing.

COURSE: FIRE PREVENTION INSPECTOR CERTIFICATION (90 HOURS)

Prerequisites: IMS-200, IMS-700, IMS-800

This is a basic incident management level course for incidents using single and multiple resources during a single operational period. Upon completion, students will be eligible to receive IMS Level 1 certification from NJDFS.

Prerequisites: IMS-100, IMS-700, IMS-800

COURSE: INCIDENT MANAGEMENT LEVEL 400 (14HOURS) (NJOEM COURSE #25-026)

LEAD INSTRUCTOR: CHIEF MCKAY

DATES: MONDAY MAY 12th @ 6pm, WEDNESDAY MAY 14th @ 6pm, & SATURDAY MAY 17th @ 8am

This is a basic incident management level course for incidents using single and multiple resources during a single operational period. Upon completion, students will be eligible to receive IMS Level 3 certification from NJDFS.

Prerequisites: IMS-300, IMS-700, IMS-800

COURSE: AERIAL APPRATUS OPERATOR & TRUCK COMPANY OPERATIONS

LEAD INSTRUCTOR: DIRECTOR GORMAN

DATES: TUESDAY MAY 6th @ 6:30PM, THURSDAY MAY 8th @ 6:30PM, TUESDAY MAY 13th @ 6:30pm, THURSDAY MAY 15th @ 6:30pm & SATURDAY 24th @ 8:30AM

This class consists of classroom lecture and hands on operations. Students will receive instruction on the following topics; ladder placement, scrub area, stabilizers, different types of aerial apparatus, VEIS, Forcible Entry, ground ladder use, placement, ventilation, Search & Rescue, & patient packing.

Prerequisites: Firefighter Level 1 & 2

COURSE: BASIC PUMP OPERATIONS (PUMP SCHOOL)

LEAD INSTRUCTOR: CHIEF NOVAK

DATES: MONDAY JUNE 2nd @ 6:30PM, WEDNESDAY JUNE 4th @ 6:30PM, SATURDAY JUNE 7th @ 8:30AM, MONDAY JUNE 9th, WEDNESDAY JUNE 11th @ 6:30PM, & SATURDAY JUNE 14th @ 8:30AM

Students will receive instruction on the basics of fire department hydraulics, theory of lift and drafting, basic pump construction and gauges. Students will be given instruction on the theory of friction loss in fire hose. Students will be given some basic rule of thumb friction loss calculations that can be used on the fireground. Students will be required to attend two hands on days of pump operations. Students will be taught how to operate a pump from draft, tank to pump and from a hydrant. Students will be given some basic fireground hose layouts and will be required to provide the adequate flow for each hose line.

Students will be required to pass a written test at the end of the course to receive certification


